## CREATING MORE KINDERGARTEN PLACES ACROSS VICTORIA

The Allan Labor Government is giving Victorian families more kindergarten options, delivering capacity grants to build new kinders and expand existing services, creating additional kinder places across the state.

Minister for Children Lizzie Blandthorn today announced the latest recipients of the Labor Government's Building Blocks Capacity Grants, investing a total of \$16.9 million across five local government areas and creating over 300 kindergarten places – giving local families bigger and better kindergartens close to home.

Services receiving funding in this round are:

- Gowrie Victoria in Carlton North
- Oxley Kids in Chirnside Park
- Lucas Kindergarten in Alfredton
- Hardy's Road Family and Community Centre in Cranbourne East
- Sebastopol Community Hub (interim name) in Ballarat
- Dromana Preschool Inc in Dromana

The Building Blocks Capacity Building stream offers grants to help increase capacity through new or expanded kindergartens, with these 6 projects bringing the total grants this year to 18 which will all open across 2025 and 2026. Through total funding of \$47,658,462, creating approximately 896 new places.

Capacity grant funding has already increased significantly since the introduction of free Three-Year-Old Kindergarten, with grants now scaled in line with the number of new places created.

The Labor Government's nation-leading \$14 billion *Best Start, Best Life* reforms are transforming early childhood education, saving families money and making it easier for parents to return to work or study if they choose.

As part of the *Victorian Budget 2023/24*, the Labor Government is continuing to deliver the kindergarten infrastructure Victoria needs – investing an additional \$1.2 billion for new kinders at or near government and low-fee non-government schools, alongside new and expanded kinders on local government sites.
