AWARDS CELEBRATE VICTORIAN WORK ON DISABILITY INCLUSION

The outstanding achievements of Victorians that promote the rights and inclusion of people with disability have been celebrated at the 2024 Victorian Disability Awards.

On behalf of the Minister for Disability Lizzie Blandthorn, the Parliamentary Secretary for Disability Iwan Walters congratulated the winners of this year's awards – individuals and organisations working towards a fairer, more inclusive state for people living with disability.

The awards ceremony was held on Tuesday, 3 December, to celebrate International Day of Persons with Disabilities.
