Builder A.W Nicholson completed these works that also delivered a new teaching space, partial refurbishment and landscaping – creating 22 jobs during construction including 3,500 hours of apprenticeship work.

The Labor Government has invested more than \$17.6 million in East Loddon College to upgrade and modernise facilities.
